Baronial Business Aleeting Alinutes June 6th, 2006

Meeting started at 7:45

Old Business:

Birthday (From Kelly's notes:)

Advertising:

I have a "pretty" version of the flyer--a one page quick blurb with color and pretty pictures that has all the basic info and includes the website. It's now living happily on the files page of the baronial website, and I can also e-mail it to anyone who needs. Molly volunteered to pass out flyers at Highland River Melees. Can I get someone to do the same at:

- -King's Assessment
- -Storvik Novice/Unbelt Tourney
- -Any Other Events (Feel free to volunteer for a specific one)

Please let me know if you're doing this so I can be sure events are covered.

Rose volunteered to help sponsor an Acorn advertisement. A half-page ad is \$40, and a full page is \$60. We get October and November free of charge, and if we want to advertise in the September and/or Aug. issues, that has to be in by the first day of the month before. (If we want to go as far ahead as August--if people want to sponsor that much--the ad has to be in by July Ist.) Do we want to buy extra advertising? Just September, or October too? Half a page, a whole page, or a quarter page? Or do we want to see who volunteers what and go based on the dollar amount we have?

Also, since Relay can work as sort of a demo, we may want to take some flyers there as well.

Directions:

I wrote directions, and they're on the website flyer, but I can't navigate my way out of a wet paper bag. Does anyone who hasn't been to the site have time to "road test" the directions?

Royalty Stuff:

At the meeting, we talked about inviting the current highnesses, who will then be their majesties, and whoever ends up being "highnesses" at that point. Can someone please send me a sample of a royalty invite you've sent in the past or give me an idea of how to go about that?

Tourney Stuff:

I'd like to get together with the 2 other champions, the B&B, and MOL to figure out specifics for tourneys. What, when, where, scheduling, logistics, etc. etc.

Making Stuff:

Serena, when you need help with tokens, let us know. (And how are those coming?) We also want to make a bunch of stuff for this event, including parking signs, waterbearer baldrics (which will be used for the event but fall more into the "general baronial stuff" category). Times and places for "sweatshops" still need to be set up.

Waterbearing/Chirurgeon

Can people donate food towards waterbearing (pickles, pretzels, oranges, etc.)? Let me know if, what, and how much.

Set-Up/Clean-Up

Need volunteers to set up and clean up. I asked Gorn to be in charge of clean-up again; not sure if he can or not.

Relay for Life:

More information will be available after Thursday regarding the final details. Laurie will be there early to setup. Request that the first laps be done in garb to impress the natives and we will be setting things up for handing out information as a demo and to show off the usual cool SCAdian stuff.

New Chatelain

Rose stepped down as Chatelaine and Alex was voted in as her replacement.

Challenge of the Heart:

Still waiting on the check for the deposit. We were expecting the check to have been here at the time of the meeting delivered by Marvin and Marcia directly, or if she was unable to attend then the check was to have been delivered to Bobbi earlier in the day. Sharon will contact the site directly to find out the status on the check and to see if the site will deal with the Barony of Dun Carraig and its officers or if they'll still only deal with Marvin/Marcia. The response from the site will determine the future value of the site to Dun Carraig.

Since we had to file the report to Kingdom without the refund of the deposit we took a loss on the event. The amount of loss would have been at least \$275 and possibly higher. However thanks to the donations and buy-back of excess materials from Laurie (site tokens), Hank (buy-back of excess) and Kiri (decorations) the loss was minimized to \$49.57. However James pointed out that COH is the big money maker for the Barony and while \$50 doesn't seem like much, that was money that we didn't make for the Barony.

When we are finally given the refund check from the site, the money will be considered a donation and will not be applied towards the event. Since the final financial numbers are already sent to Kingdom they can not be altered.

Next meeting will be at the church at 7:30 on the 18^{th} of July. The lateness is due to the fact that the 4^{th} of July would have been the day of the meeting.

Officer's Badges:

Badges? Yes we need steenking badges! A counting was taken and we discovered that 5 of the officer positions didn't have the nice metal badges of office. A vote was taken at the officers meeting and was voted again at the meeting approving the acquisition of the ones missing.

Anne Marie Gardens Demo:

Alex brought up the possibility of doing a small demo at Anne Marie Gardens. Further details are in the Castellan's report.

Equipment replacement:

Approval was given to James to go shopping for replacements for worn out equipment. Replacement Rattan and a new Archery Target

Donated lumber was delivered to James' house to make the list fence.

Evan purchased the leather as voted upon in previous meetings and is currently working on refurbishing the loaner armor.

Misc:

Thanks to Erwin for his \$20 donation to the Barony.

Thanks to Bobbi, Alex, and Bobbi's son's girlfriend for getting the banner done in a timely manner. They didn't have much time but it was done and done well. It looked very nice among the rest of the Atlantian Baronies' banners.

B-n-B was given suggestions on whom next to be given awards. However some of the awards need the symbol designed. If they don't come up with the design, then they don't "get any bling"

Minna is going to give Bobbi the information of the water bottles for water bearing.

Officer's reports

MOL – Nothing at this time

B-n-B – Need equipment as mentioned above

Herald – Still trying to light a fire under the powers that be in order to get warranted.

Chirurgeon – Needs to attend two more events before she can be warranted

Castellan – During a fever induced altered mental state, Alisandair volunteered and was voted in to replace Rose whom stepped down. Also is going to look into the possibility of a demo at Anne Marie Gardens. It's for their "Tales of the Haunted Trail" safe trick-or-treating event. Alex will find out more information as to what we need and what we can/can't do and the vote will be taken next month. Alex will Autocrat the demo if approved.


MoAS – Still getting things together for classes (ideas, instructors, etc)
