A few little fixes. Hoping to do more after Birthday, e.g. database-driven announcements would be nice.

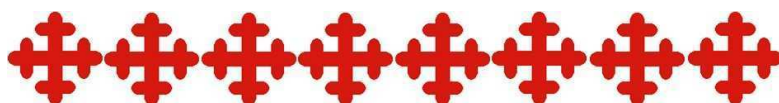
Exchequer's Report

Account balance \$6205.04 as of 10/30/12. Quarterly report completed & filed 10/6/12. Review of books completed with Kingdom Exchequer at Atlantean Coronation. Only action from Kingdom is to add amendment for Emergency Financial Committee to Baronial Financial Policy. Serena (Bobby Sprouse) is working on amendment. Must be completed & approved by 2/9/2013 (delta review at Bright Hills).

Upcoming feast expenditures at Baronial Birthday (note- exch. is also cook): Feast adjusted downward due to low pre-reg, was 50 to sell + 6 comp, now 40 to sell + 8 comp. Budget now \$320. Shopping nearly complete, \$298 spent. Anticipate not exceeding budget by more than \$10. Will deliver \$100 seed money check to Troll (Roberta Sprouse) tonight after meeting. Bring all receipts to event & give to Troll. Exch. trying to submit event report by 11/15, Regional has granted 1-week extension (to 12/1) if required.
