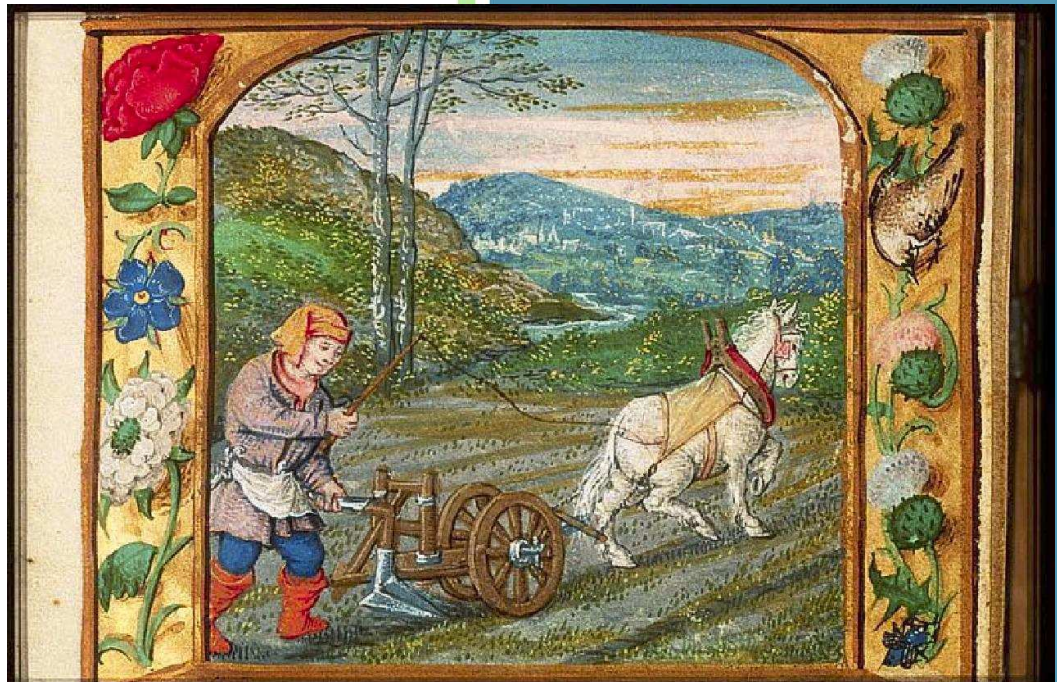

April Business Meeting Minutes

April 2, 2013

In attendance: Ceridwen, Harald, Mary, Richard, Matthew, Adriana, Serena, Karl, Amalia, Cadfan, Lynette, Ragnarr, Chris, Ysane, Elizabeth.

Business Meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month, 7:00pm at Big Larry’s Comic Book Cafe, Leonardtown, MD 20650. For directions go to duncarraig.net/directions.shtml

Old Business:

Birthdays: Amalia has copy of contract from Melwood, but somebody took our date. Will check on dates at end of August or end of September, she prefers Aug 31. Matthew will cook. Discussed theme ideas: Cadfan's “Day in the Uttermost West”, Hollywood, others – will ask on list for ideas. Group is OK if she goes ahead & spikes. Will need somebody to direct cars, there is not an obvious parking area. Alcohol – specific requirements at site, may require SCA insurance rider (\$50). Hall is \$550, no extra charge for grounds (\$600 with rider). Hall seats 150. Seneschal & Exchequer will look at contract. Need to explicitly put use of fields in contract.

Archery: Karl von Konigsberg is now autocrat. Everything “chugging along.” Acorn posted curia. Discussed royal desire for charity event (for American Cancer Society), maybe \$1 an arrow “turkey shoot.” No reservations yet.

Financial policy: should be hearing back from oversight committee in a week or so. Maybe 1 or 2 tweaks needed; looking pretty good.

Storage unit: Current shed is 8 x 10. 10 x 10 units have normal prices of \$100-\$120 per month, with a discount to about \$95/month if we contract for several years. History of shed – not a depreciated item,

we're free to sell as we please, (exch?) has an idea on how to report. If we go for a storage unit, we will need to bring in more money for. Discussed broadening appeal of events with good schtick to pull people in, look at how we budget for events. Discussed trailer as an option, can park for about \$20/month, but needs someone to haul & insurance. After seeing costs, the shed looks more appealing, and exchequer cannot endorse the cost of storage rental. Shed may not survive being taken apart for moving. Matthias will look at base for price of new shed. The 3 issues with the shed are location, state of shed, state of things inside shed. Elizabeth offered her home as new location for a shed. Populace approved a motion to send about 3 people to Elizabeth's to see site.

New Business:

Seneschal trying to codify how we choose officers. In other groups, either populace vote or (more commonly) baronage makes decision.

Once decided, we need to choose A&S officer.

What Chris has seen work best in other groups – existing officer, BnB, seneschal decide on who they can work with. Populace vote has merits, but can get ugly.

Procedure is different for some offices, Kingdom has procedures for some. It's a separate issue if Kingdom does not accept the person for the office.

Discussion leaned toward BnB deciding; but secret vote would lead to more general acceptance; but where&when issues with secret votes, proxies. Straw poll: 11 BnB choose, 2 voting populace, 2 abstained. Discussed option of vote from populace with BnB having final say.

Tabled this issue for discussion later.

The 2 A&S candidates settled it at the meeting - Amalia will be A&S officer, Elizabeth will be her assistant. Approved by acclamation.



B & B's Report

Next weekend is Coronation, only April event for BnB. Going to more next month – Crown, neighboring events. We are one of 2 principles in War of the Wings, want to “bring an army that will make them cry.”
