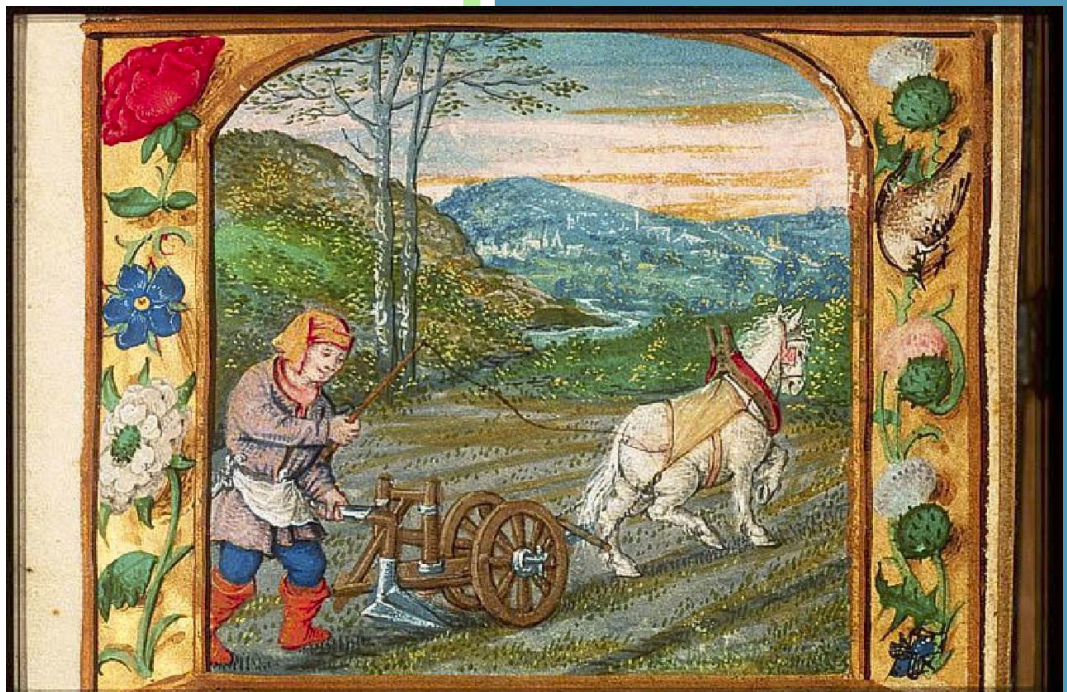

Chirurgion's Report

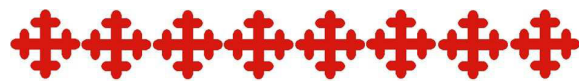

Will keep putting up info as it comes in.

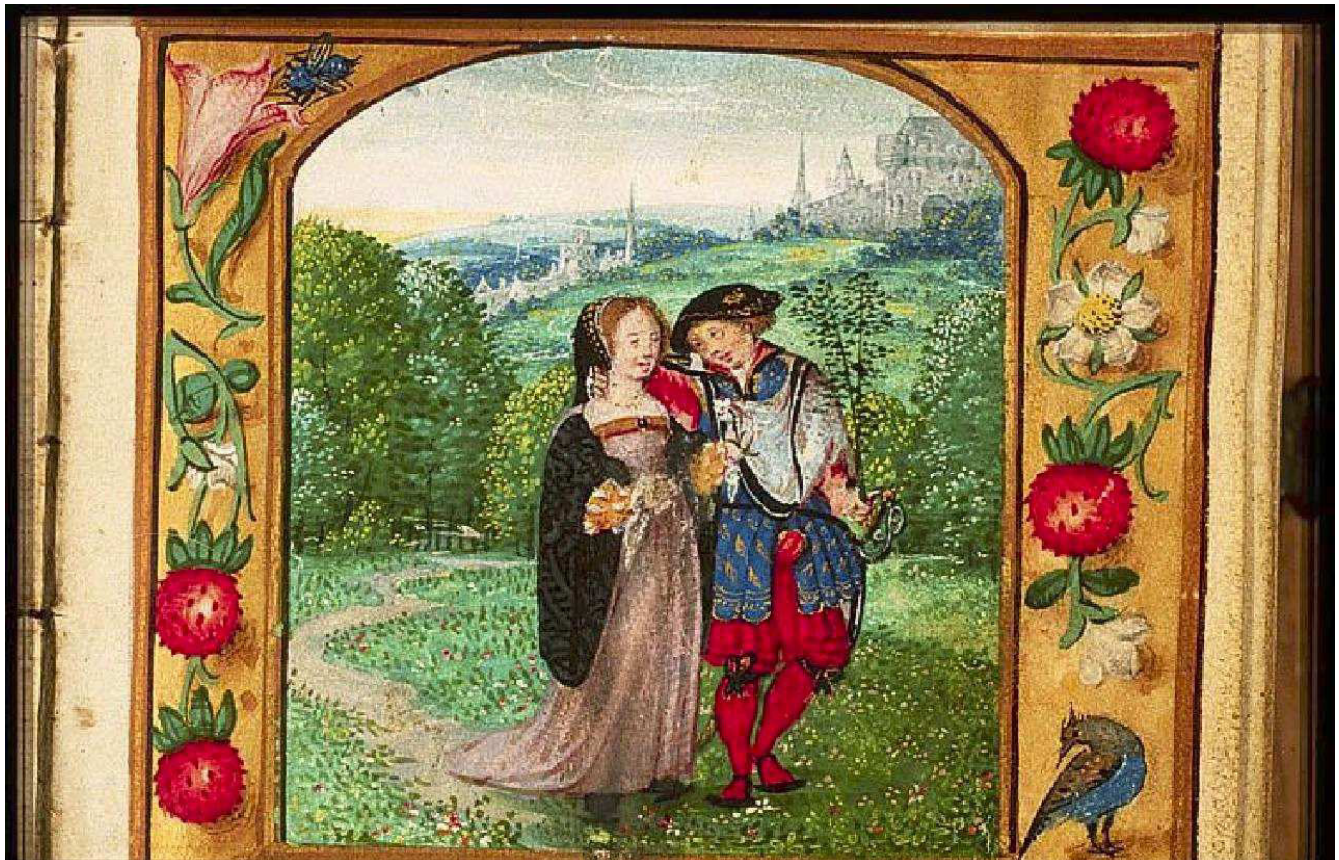
Exchequer's Report
