Rufflers, Wild Rogues, Priggers of Prancers, Abraham Men, Whip-jacks, Counterfeit Cranks, Bawdy Baskets, Kinchin Coes, and more. A couple of my favorites:

A Patrico - a sort of hedge-priest - performed marriages which should hold until death did part the married couple. This meant that whenever they were tired of living together they could be divorced over the body of any dead animal they found in the road, by shaking hands and parting, the husband on one side of it, the wife on the other. (page 19)

The Minstrels, roaming up and down the land singing bawdy ballads and furnishing music in taverns, at fairs, and at country wakes and feasts, were in very bad repute. But at the same time they were very popular. (page 43)

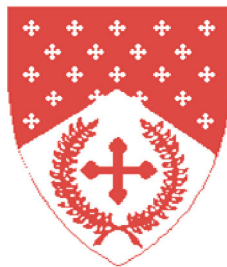

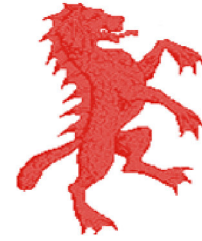

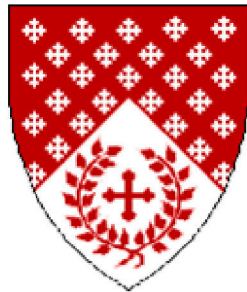
