Chirurgion's Report

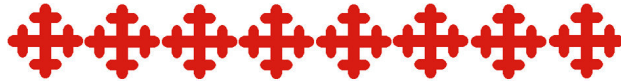
No report.

Not at meeting - will email financials from University (*will print next month*).



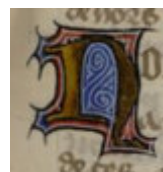
