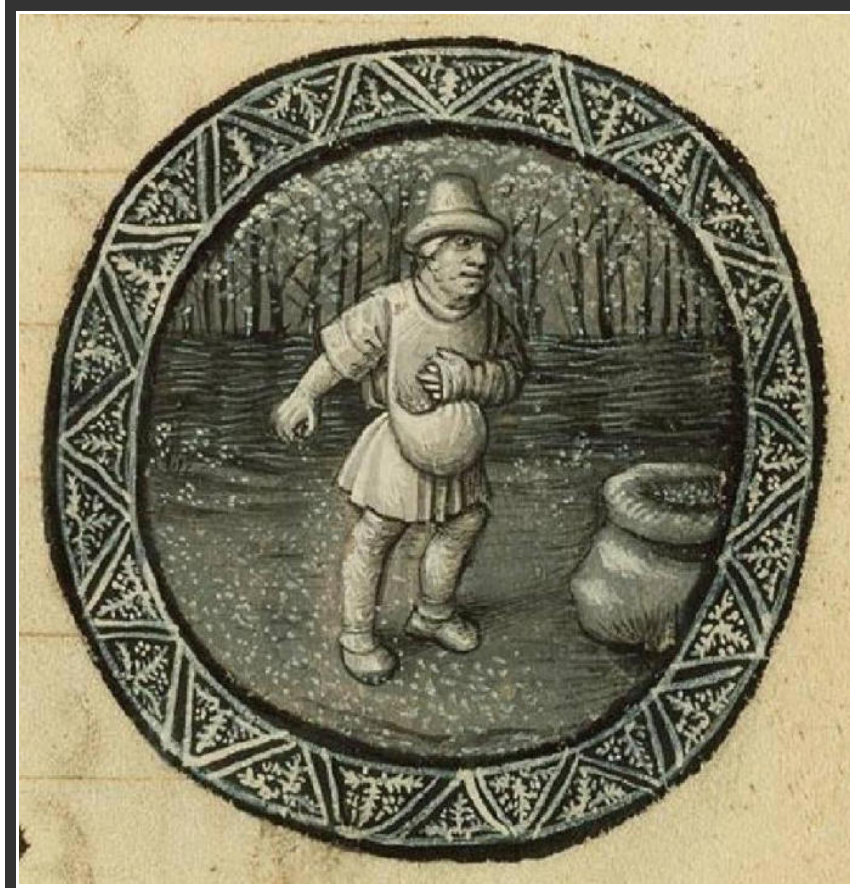

Adriana, Alexina, Joshua, Maria.

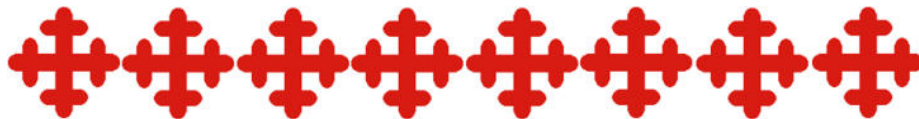

### Knight Marshal's Report *(via Seneschal)*

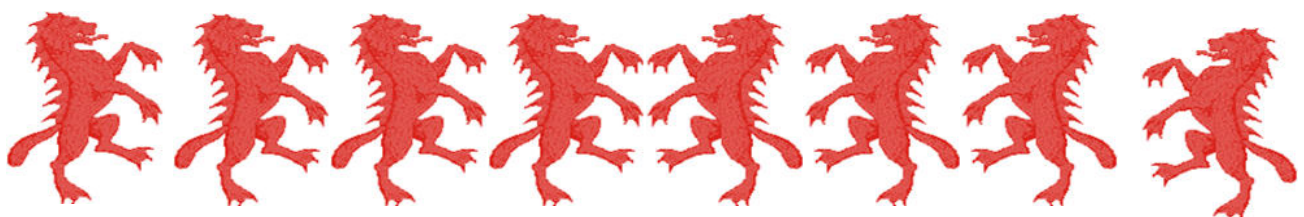
Marguerite is still trying to get her warrant finalized. Caitilín - practices have been pretty sparse while Harald is away; sometimes Wednesday marshal has not been available.

## Chronicler's Choice



I went looking for something related to 16th-century Spain, because our upcoming Birthday theme is "The Splendors of the Spanish Empire." These two documents caught my eye because of their splendid decoration - the ornamented initials in the later one, and the page frames in the earlier one (one was used to frame the letter from the Baronage, above). The carta executoria was a document issued in the name of the king, usually to confirm a citizen's noble status.

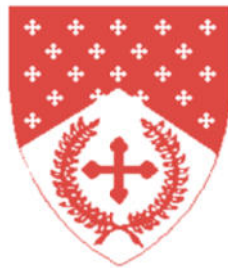

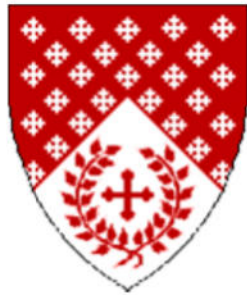
