Seneschal: Exchequer should do yearly review of financial policy, have meeting with financial committee, before Doomsday report.



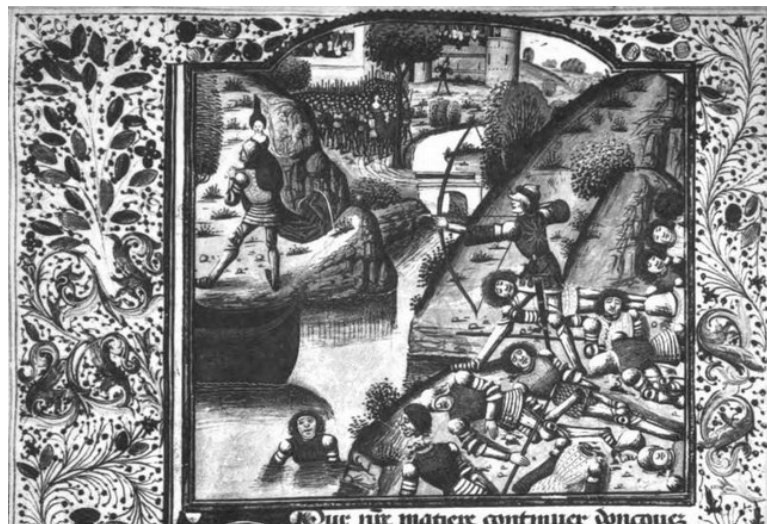

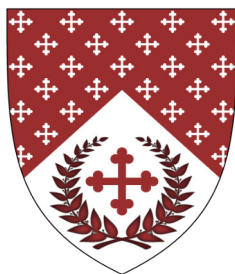

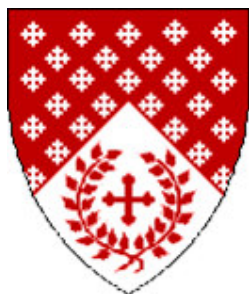
