Upcoming activities & events

Last Chance fighter practice in July before Pennsic - There were problems with the site, Nils has possible alternative site. Backup site is Lusby Community Center. Ponte Alto is planning a Last Chance, probably 7/15 or 7/16 - work together with them? Combine with them?

Fall Coronation 10/7 - our bid was accepted. Site is Charles County Fairgrounds. Alexina is event steward. May need a backup field coordinator. May need extra help with outdoor cooking setup. We will have access to the fairgrounds from 8AM Friday to 8AM Sunday, per contract.

Discussed online sign up - cost is 3.9% + 1%; too new, too expensive.

Discussed cleaning - do ourselves, or pay their staff \$30/hour each- discussion favored doing it ourselves.

Spring Coronation bid at Camp Merrick - Kingdom would rather not do back-to-back events in same barony, but we'd get it if there were no other bids. We need a cutoff date for the bid decision, to keep Camp Merrick registration.

Investiture spiked 12/9. All positions are open. Need to decide on registration method - test online system? Increase the price, or the cabin price, to cover online fees? Consensus was to increase the cabin fee to cover online charge, since cabins require pre-registration.

Birthday activities: Garb competition, perhaps 6 hours to make some piece of garb, only get your model on site. Do this in feast area? Has a volunteer to run it & a judge volunteer.

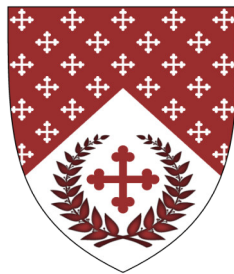

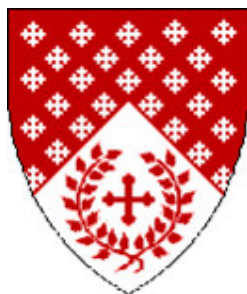
