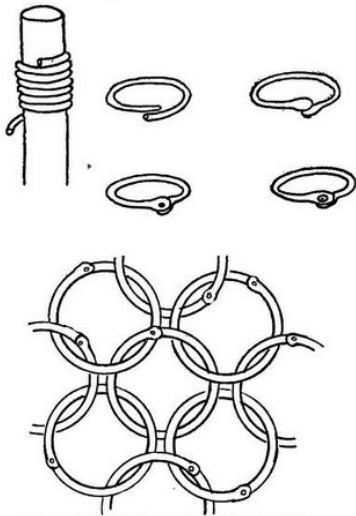


FIG. 18. Method of making mail.

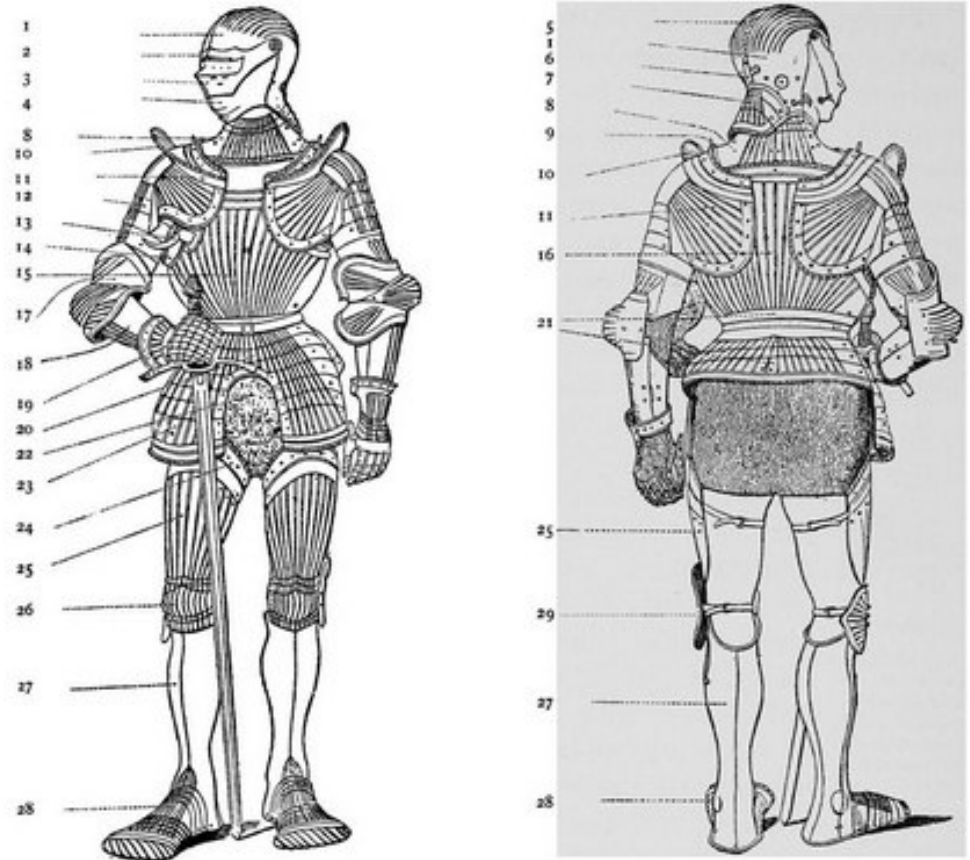


FIG. 58. Sixteenth-century Suit of Plate.

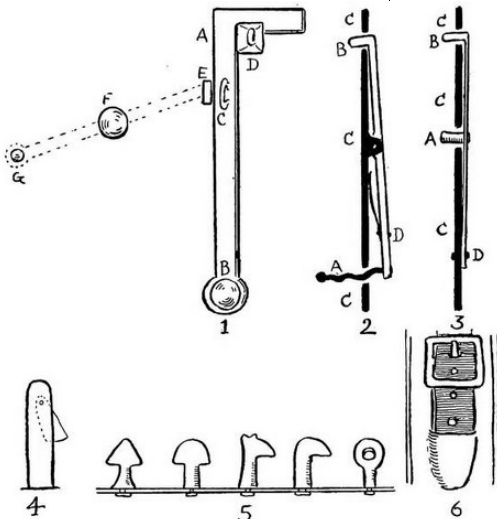
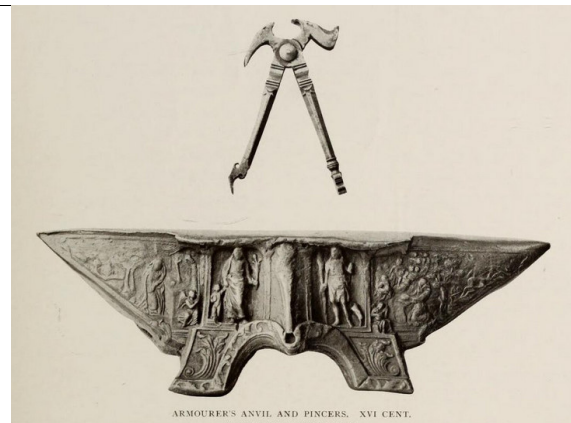


FIG. 33. Locking hooks, turning pins, and strap-cover.

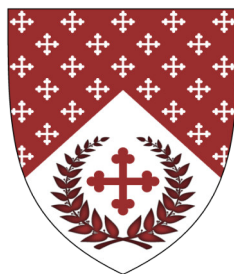

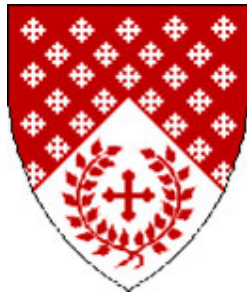
